<b>Eye Contact</b>	No eye contact with audience, as entire presentation is read.	Displayed minimal eye contact with audience, while reading mostly from notes	Consistent use of eye contact with audience, by still returns to notes. <b>Elocution</b>	Student mumbles, incorrectly pronounces words, and speaks too quietly for audience to hear.	Student's voice is low. Student uses a clear voice and correct, precise pronunciation of terms so that audience can hear presentation.
